



Division Definitions and Guidelines

Team Captains: Please be sure to inform your players that this is a charity tournament. No fighting, disrespect towards referees, scorekeepers, or staff will be tolerated.

The definitions and guidelines ranges presume a natural progression over time for players. Some exceptions due to injury, fitness, and time off may apply at the discretion of the tournament director. If you have a question or concern about a potential player please ask!

Division Definitions

Filthy Mitts (Gold – A and B league)

- Includes players with ice, inline, or pond hockey experience including professional, collegiate, and juniors.
- Open to players with professional, NCAA, ACHA, junior, or AAA experience.

Dusters (Silver – B league through D league)

- Includes intermediate level and competitive adult hockey players.
- Open to players that played youth travel hockey, high school, or adult hockey.
- Closed to players with recent professional, NCAA D1, or major junior experience.

Beauties (Bronze – D league or lower)

- Includes new, novice, and recreational hockey players.
- Open to players with very limited or no youth hockey experience.
- Closed to players with recent professional, NCAA, ACHA D1 and D2, junior, competitive high school, or AAA experience.

Guidelines

- All players must be at least 18 years old.
- Open to men or women.
- 7 players per team. No goaltenders.

Tournament Information

- 30 team adult hockey tournament
- 3 divisions, 3 games per team
- Ages 18 and up
- 3v3 pond hockey style indoor tournament at the Promenade Ice Centre in Westminster
 - No goalies, box goals will be used.
- Fundraiser for Ashton Stephenson, 19-year-old hockey player who was paralyzed in October 2022.
